The hall continues to be used for the following activities:-

The local Police Community Support Officer also uses the hall as a base during selected days and hours.

The finances remain in the black. However, the 200 Club has been stopped due to lack of subscription, a sign of the economic climate. Therefore the support of the Parish Council in contributing to the insurance cost remains paramount.

The caretaker/cleaner arrangements continue to work very well.

We resolved the outstanding snagging issues with Terrapin and this has been concluded.

However, funds are still needed for the construction of a patio area. While we will continue with grant applications this process will undoubtedly be affected by the current climate.

We will continue to monitor activities and revenue in the coming months.
